Notice to Abate

By virtue of Section 1 of Riverside County Ordinance No. 772 you are hereby NOTIFIED and REQUIRED to abate dead orchard, vineyard, or grove from your property, described as () taken from the Riverside County Assessor's records lists you as the owner, by removing said vegetation from the entire parcel. If your parcel is over 5 acres in size, please see the special instructions below.

If said dead orchard, grove or vineyard is not removed within THIRTY (30) days from the above date, the County Fire Chief, or other duly assigned officers may order said property cleared by public employees, private contractors, or other persons, and the cost of said removal shall be levied with an additional ADMINISTRATIVE FEE, and assessed against the property as a SPECIAL LIEN.

APPEALS INFORMATION

An APPEAL from this order may be taken by presenting a WRITTEN APPEAL to the HAZARD REDUCTION OFFICE at PO Box 2047 Perris, CA 92572-2047 Tel: (951) 943-0640 within TWENTY (20) calendar days of the post mark on the NOTICE TO ABATE. The Hazard Reduction Officer shall set the same for hearing before the Board of Appeals, and shall notify the Applicant in writing of the hearing date. If you receive notices on adjacent parcels of property and you wish them abated as one piece of land, contact this office in writing within 30 days of the date shown. If you do not make the prior arrangements with us and the work is done, the adjacent parcels will be billed separately for the cost of abatement and administration charges. Also, it is necessary that these arrangements be renewed , in writing, each year.

Special Instructions:

Parcels over 5 acres in size shall remove or chip dead trees and mow or disc 100 feet around entire parcel and 100 foot fire breaks dividing the parcel into 2.5 acre sections. Ensure that the Improved methods are consistent with environmental needs.

Chipping shall not be more than 3 inches in depth.

If your property has been cleared, please disregard this notice
