Description: This course provides preparation for participants to demonstrate competency in dynamic water rescue. It will familiarize participants with the dynamic water environment, experience, and prepare them to safely execute simple to complex rescue techniques.

Awarded: CSFSM Water Rescue Technician Certificate

- * Rope Rescue Awareness and Operations (SFT, FEMA, or IFSAC/Pro Board) **or** Low Angle Rope Rescue **and** Rescue Systems 1
- * Common Passenger Vehicle or Auto Extrication or Vehicle Extrication
- * IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800 (FEMA)

Bring: Males: Rash guard/t-shirt and long board shorts. Females: One piece bathing suit and/or board shorts, rash guard/t-shirt. appropriate footwear: heavy soled water booties-mesh upper tennis shoes (NO SANDALS) Nice to have duct tape, towel, insect repellent, shade cover, folding chair, sunscreen, fluids for drinking, and flashlight (submersible to 5 meters).
