## **Description: Water Rescue Technician**

This course is an intensive hands-on training program that will prepare you to respond to confined space emergencies. This course of instruction prepares the student in identifying; confined spaces and permit required confined spaces, the hazards associated with permit required confined spaces, targets industries and hazards, state and federal regulations, components of a rescue operation, and the roles and responsibilities of the rescue team.

**Bring:** Males: Rash guard/t-shirt and long board shorts. Females: One piece bathing suit and/or board shorts, reash guard/t-shirt. appropriate footwear: heavy soled water booties-mesh upper tennis shoes (NO SANDALS) Nice to have duct tape, towel, insect repellent, shade cover, folding chair, sunscreen, fluids for drinking, and flashlight (submersible to 5 meters).
