**Description:** The course is designed for a Public Information Officer (PIO) assigned to an incident as a member of an All-Hazards management Team (AHIMT) and local IMT as well as for the PIO assigned to an incident as an Assistant PIO in a variety of capacities. This class meets the requirements for CAL FIRE and CICC for PIO 3. This course is an instructor-led training that supports learning through discussion, lecture, and active participation in multiple exercises that provide a realistic scenario-driven approach to mastering the skills required of a PIO. Exercises, simulations, discussions, and a final exam enable participants to process and apply their new knowledge.

**Pre-requisites:** IS or ICS 100, 200, 300, 400, IS 700, and IS 800
